Old Wintonians Association Summer Reunion

July 8th, 9th & 10th 2022

Dear Fellow Wintonian

We are delighted to be contacting you again after our enforced Covid break, and hope that you will not have forgotten the delights of attending Reunion since we were last able to be together in 2019.

Since that time, things have radically changed with The Winton Club as you will have known it, and I hope to explain the resulting situation here.

You will know that The Winton Club is almost as old as the institute which is now the University of Winchester. 'The Reunion Club' first met in 1874 and has continued to provide an opportunity for old classmates to meet again, but also for newer members to meet and exchange reminiscences with Wintonians from times gone by. The Winton Club was an autonomous body run by Wintonians with the support of the College, but Reunion was self supporting through charges for meals and accommodation, and administrative costs covered by a small membership subscription (50p in 1974!) and generous donations to the Club's General Fund. Donations were also invited to the Benevolent Fund for the 'immediate relief of distress and hardship' of Wintonians.

In 1998 the then Principal launched 'The King Alfred's Alumni Association' which overlapped with the aims and objectives of The Winton Club, but which was seen by many as a means to raise funds for the institution through donations and bequests from alumni. Members of The Winton Club were invited to join the association.

In 2001 the Winton Club committee considered the proposal that the two Alumni bodies would amalgamate, and this was accepted at the 2002 AGM held at the summer reunion. It meant that the College would accept the financial responsibility for the running of the Club, and the levy of an annual subscription would cease. In the years following, while Reunion was still largely organised by the Winton Club committee, much of the administration was taken in house by the Alumni Office at the College.

By 2017 it had become obvious that the summer Reunion appealed primarily to older Wintonians of the King Alfred's era, but the now thousands of younger graduates of the University were not being catered for. The result was the creation of the Alumni Strategy Group which was envisaged as an 'umbrella' under which the Old Wintonians, as we were to become, would sit alongside other groups to be set up with specific roles relating to alumni activities. The Old Wintonians would have oversight of reunions and heritage, and would maintain control of the Benevolent Fund: the whole body of Alumni would adopt the title 'The Winton Club', now to be known as 'The Winton Society'.

During the Covid-19 hiatus the University widened its alumni focus to encourage reunions, events and activities from all decades. It is, however unable to maintain the financial and staff resources previously given to our Reunion, and so we will revert to the old system of the Old Wintonians Committee organising the summer Reunion, but ensuring it is fully self-funding.

Thus, when you come to read charges for booking, you will see that, with regret, charges are slightly higher and we are having to ask you to pay an administration fee to cover the costs involved. Though the Alumni Office will send out and receive electronic messages, some members still use conventional post, and we have now to pay for some services previously covered in-house. We do hope this will not deter you from making a booking to take part in all or part of Reunion Weekend to enjoy the opportunity to be back at the place we called home!

There are some small changes to the usual programme, and we draw your attention particularly to the Memorial Service for Martial Rose to be held on Friday afternoon, and the N.U.S. Centenary celebrations, hosted by the Student Union, on Saturday evening, open to all attending the Old Wintonians Reunion. Full details of all events will be sent on receipt of booking.

We look forward to seeing you at Reunion 2022.
