

## GENERAL

- 1) Students must apply to, enrol and remain on a full-time undergraduate programme of study.
- 2) Students must fall under the new fee regime which came into place in September 2012.
- 3) Students must be UK, EU, Channel Island or International domiciled.
- 4) Students must have achieved a minimum of 136 UCAS points from their top 3 A Level or equivalent qualifications.
- 5) This award applies to students starting in September 2021. Students deferring entry until September 2022 will need to consult the Highflier Academic Achievement Award on offer for that year of entry.
- 6) Recipients must maintain an academic level throughout their studies to continue receiving their Highflier Academic Achievement Award in subsequent years of study (if applicable). This will be an average mark of at least 70% at the end of each year of study, as agreed by the relevant examination board.
- 7) You must remain enrolled as a full-time student for the duration of the course. Variation from the course (changing to part-time study etc.) may affect your eligibility for the Highflier Academic Achievement Award.
- 8) Recipients will be required to help promote the University through press releases and University publicity materials.

## **APPLICATIONS**

- 9) No specific direct application needs to be made for the Highflier Academic Achievement Award. The University will make their assessment using the data supplied on your application and your confirmed entry qualifications.
- 10) The University may ask for proof of qualifications if required.

## PAYMENTS

- 11) The award value for 2021/22 entrants is £200.00 per academic year, subject to the conditions as stated above. The award will be paid in a single instalment in February of the academic year.
- 12) Any debt owed to the University of Winchester will be offset against the award.
- 13) Withdrawal and/or interruption of study may affect your entitlement to the Highflier Academic Achievement Award and may result in you having to return any monies received.
