


How many days per week do you typically travel to the University?






How many miles do you travel from your term-time residence to the University?



















Where do you spend most of your time?






Do you ever visit Bar End?





Which mode of transport do you use most often to travel to Bar End?







Do you ever travel to King Alfred Quarter, West Downs Quarter or Medecroft?





Which mode of transport do you use most often to travel to KAQ, WDQ or Medecroft?








Which of the following would encourage you to start or continue to travel in a more sustainable way? Please select all that apply.






